Minutes of the Meeting~June 4, 2009 *Michael's Restaurant~Weirs Beach, NH*

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

There was discussion about upcoming boating courses for the public. Steve Whyland went over the schedule for classes. The cost of the classes this year will be \$35. Per person or \$45 for 2 people sharing a book. Ron Lavoie has taught classes at Owens Marine on Route 28 in Hooksett. Ron had 8 students in May and all of them passed. Steve set up dates for upcoming classes as follows: July 18th @ Independent Marine to be taught by Bob & Irene, August 15 at the Laconia Boys & Girls Club, and September 19th at the Moultonborough Library to be taught by Bob & Irene Saunders. If anyone needs to sign up for classes they may call Irene Saunders. All classes start @ 9:00 am and anyone attending should bring a lunch. Steve discussed the phone account and presently Irene will be taking messages. The maximum number for any one class will be 35 students. Steve also talked about the lack of enough books for classes and is in the process of ordering more. Steve went over instructor's booklets and introduced new ways to make the teaching more manageable.

Treasurer Bob Saunders reported total income for the month of May \$2814, 63. Only 16 people paid their membership dues. \$255 was revenue from the classes that Ron taught. There are presently a lot of expenses for books, etc. Bob expects the income to increase soon with classes, etc. All present approved of Bob Saunders purchasing a laser printer for the squadron. Mal motioned to accept the Treasures report and all were in favor.

Irene Saunders presented a VSC report. Irene has set up a schedule for the summer but is still in need of volunteers at some of the locations. Irene distributed the bags of supplies to all VSC Officers.

The annual barbeque at Irwin Marine is scheduled for Sunday July 12 at noon time. It will be inside so it will take place rain or shine. Everyone should bring a dish to share,

and their own beverage. Steve said the Squadron will furnish hamburgers and hotdogs. There will be an ExCom meeting at 11:00 before the cookout. Lisa Prucha will send out more information.

Mal made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:50 Irene Saunders seconded the motion and the meeting was adjourned. .
